Monthly Sailing Schedule

The following Sailing schedule (weather permitting) can be put into your yearly calendar.

Day Sail 2nd Saturday of each month, arrive at dock by 09:30am. Departure time is 30 minutes later at 10:00am. Expect to sail till 2pm (more or less) depending on sailing conditions.

Day Sail 4th Sunday of each month, arrive at dock by 12:30 pm. Departure time is 30 minutes later at 1pm. Expect to sail till 5pm (more or less) depending on sailing conditions.

Overnight sails will commence in March and alternate every other month till the heat of the summer.

Special sails, for example (additional sails, weekday sails, non-scheduled, etc) will be announce through the SBSYC newsletter and/or official SBSYC email (sbsycinfo@yahoo.com).

Sailing sign-ups will be through Cheryl Reinerio (Fleet-Captain) at <cherylreinerio@yahoo.com>. Sign up is on a 'first-come, first served basis' based on the time stamp arrival of your email. This also means only (1) email per SBSYC member per sailing event. You may enter your email request for the current month as well as the following month.

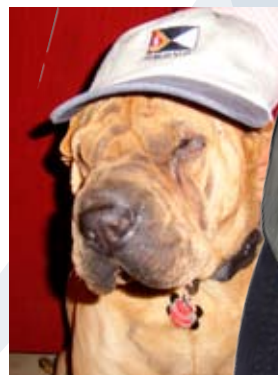
Social Events
